At the University of Missouri, the Men’s Basketball won 4 consecutive Big 8 Championships. While at University of Alaska Fairbanks, Dr. Lashbrook created the Top of the World Basketball Tournament. RC Buford, Chief Executive Officer, Spurs Sports and Entertainment

In September of 2019, Buford was named Chief Executive Officer of Spurs Sports & Entertainment. He started his coaching career at the University of Kansas in 1983. During each of his five seasons at Kansas, the Jayhawks participated in the NCAA Tournament. Buford was an assistant coach for the team that won the 1988 NCAA Championship as well as the 1985-86 squad that advanced to the Final Four. He made the move to the NBA in the summer of 1988 joining the Spurs as an assistant coach on Larry Brown's staff (other assistants on that staff included Gregg Popovich, Alvin Gentry and Ed Manning). He spent four seasons as an assistant with the Spurs and during that time San Antonio won back-to-back Midwest Division titles (1990 and 1991). He joined the Los Angeles Clippers in the summer of 1992 as the first assistant for Coach Brown. The Clippers posted a 41-41 record during the 1992-93 season and earned a spot in the 1993 playoffs. Buford served as an assistant coach at the University of Florida during the 1993-94 season (as the team advanced to the Final Four for the first time in school history). He returned to San Antonio in the summer of 1994 when Gregg Popovich hired him as the team's head scout. In the summer of 1997 Buford became the Spurs director of scouting and was promoted to vice president/assistant general manager in the summer of 1999. He was named the Spurs general manager in July of 2002. Buford played collegiate basketball at Texas A&M University and Oklahoma State before receiving his degree from friends University. He was involved in the NBA Basketball Without Borders Africa camp, and served as a Board Member for Roy Maas' Youth Alternatives. He serves on the Board of Directors of PeacePlayers International. His wife, Beth, is a former player on the LPGA Tour and they are both active with the Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation. They have a son, Chase, a daughter, C.C., and in 2004 they welcomed Alexis Wangmene and in 2007 they welcomed Samer Jassar to their family. Wangmene is from Cameroon and met the Bufords during the Basketball Without Borders program in Johannesburg. Jassar is from Israel and was introduced to the Bufords through PeacePlayers International.

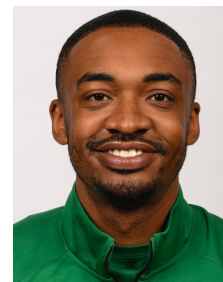


Joel Corry, Former NBA and NFL Agent – Current CBS Sports, Writer

He was the primary and co-negotiator of numerous NFL player contracts, including Hall of Famer John Randle's 5-year, \$ 32.5 million contract with the Minnesota Vikings (1998), Patrick Surtain's 6-year, \$44.63 million contract with the Kansas City Chiefs (2005), which made Patrick the highest paid player in the franchise's history. Randle's contract made him the NFL's highest-paid defensive player with unprecedented guarantees that have become the norm in the most lucrative NFL contracts. Other Premier clients included Pro Bowlers Eric Allen, Keenan McCardell and Jimmy Smith. Joel served as a consultant with Management Plus for several years after starting Premier. As a consultant, he played an integral part in the negotiation of Shaquille O'Neal's Los Angeles Lakers contracts (\$ 120 million over 7 years & subsequent 3-year, \$ 88.3 million extension). In 2012, Joel became a contributing writer for the National Football Post. He uses his NFL salary cap and collective bargaining agreement knowledge to provide a perspective on player salaries, contract negotiations and the salary cap that is rarely seen in the media. 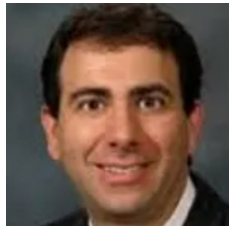

Dean wrote *Basketball on Paper* in 2002 and it was published in 2003, only months after Michael Lewis' *Moneyball* came out showing how valuable analytics already were in baseball. *Basketball on Paper* then became the handbook for how to do basketball analytics and Dean became the first analytics consultant in the NBA. He worked with Hall of Fame Coach George Karl, star players, management, and scouts to show how traditional basketball questions could be turned into more clear answers. After many successful years in the NBA, Dean joined ESPN when it wanted to build a sports analytics group. Dean guided the group to successful football and basketball metrics, while building relationships internally and externally. The QBR metric has a flexible framework to incorporate as much of a quarterback's performance as possible, including offensive line performance. His group also built a Pass Protection metric, which has been embraced as a very useful stand-alone tool for evaluating the offensive line. Prior to joining Wizards, Dean spent four years as the Vice President of Data Science at TruMedia, an engineering firm that focuses on sports analytics, bringing user-friendly interfaces to the analytics that help teams and media properties understand how the data impacts their decisions and stories. With an emphasis on "translating between words and numbers, then back again," Dean has established himself as one of the thought leaders in the age of ever-increasing sports data. **Twitter: @DeanO_Lytics**

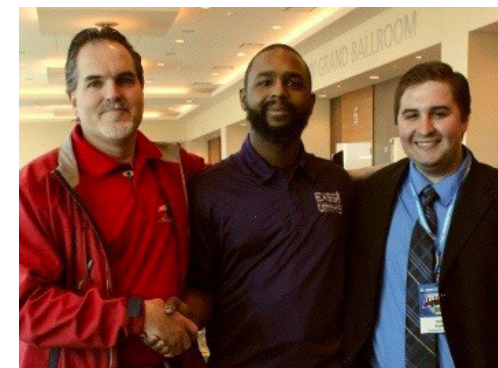


Michael Preston, Indiana Pacers Vice President Basketball Communications & Media Relations

Larry Riley, Atlanta Hawks Senior Advisor to the GM

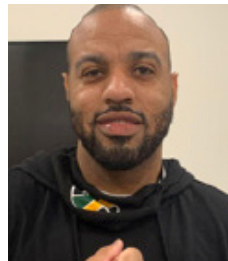

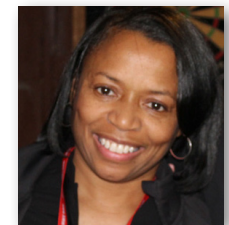

Rick Sund, Former NBA GM

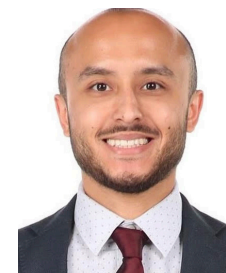
Rick Sund has more than 40 consecutive years of managerial NBA experience spanning five decades. The longtime league executive was the Atlanta Hawks Executive Vice President and General Manager from 2008-2012. Under his leadership, the Hawks won nearly 60 percent of their games (184-128), reaching the playoffs in each of his four seasons and advancing to the Eastern Conference semifinals three times. After retiring in 2012, he remained with the Hawks as Senior Advisor of basketball operations until 2019.



Formerly the General Manager of the Seattle Sonics from 2001-07, Sund and the Sonics were the inaugural champions of the Northwest Division in 2004-05, advancing to the semifinals in the Western Conference. Sund was also a member of the Detroit Pistons organization when he became Vice President of Player Personnel in 1995 and was later named Executive VP and General Manager of Basketball Operations. Prior to his time with the Pistons, he served in several executive capacities with the Dallas Mavericks. Sund was part of their expansion season in 1979 until his final season as their Vice President of Basketball Operations in 1994.

Sund began his NBA career in Milwaukee under the tutelage of famed basketball executive Wayne Embry, spending five years with the Bucks after graduating with a Master's in Sports Administration and Management from Ohio University in 1974. He is currently a consultant to the Beijing Ducks in the Chinese Basketball Association where he has been working since 2019.

What is NBA Summer League?

NBA Summer League is a 75-game, 11-day offseason competition, typically held in July, that allows players and teams alike to try out different lineups with special emphasis usually paid to rookies, bench players and members of the affiliate G League teams.

Who competes in the NBA Summer League?

While there are no hard-and-fast rules about who coaches and who front offices choose to play during NBA Summer League, don't expect to find your favorite All-Stars out there. In fact, you'd be hard-pressed to find a single starter or veteran player. Summer League is typically reserved for rookies, sophomores and G League players. Every once in a while, a team in the midst of a rebuild with lots of young talent will field their best players, but most don't want to assume the injury risk on a game without any in-season significance.

How many teams compete in the NBA Summer League?

All 30 teams will be present in Las Vegas this upcoming week.

What is the format for the NBA Summer League?

All 30 teams will compete in a series of four games from July 7 to July 15. The top-two teams based on winning percentage will then advance to a championship matchup, while the remaining 28 teams await assignments for their fifth and final game on either July 16th or 17th. The NBA announced that these consolation matchups will come down to a number of factors, including team rivalries, broadcast interest and other scheduling considerations (i.e. timing of back-to-backs). Should there be a tie-breaker between teams at the top of the leaderboard, the championship matchup will be determined by a series of tiebreakers:

Two teams tied:

- 1. Head-to-head matchup:** If those two teams played each other in one of the prior four matchups, the winning team earns the higher seed.
- 2. Point differential:** The team with the greater point differential through four games receives the higher seed.

More than two teams tied:

- 1. Point differential:** The team with the greatest point differential through four games receives the higher seed.
- 2. Random drawing:** The higher seed will be determined by a "coin flip."

When is the championship in the NBA Summer League?

The championship game is set for July 17 at 3 p.m. ET.
